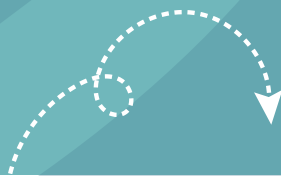

Calla Lilies

Surprise mom with a bouquet of homemade flowers this Mother's Day.

Easy to do with the kids and guaranteed to make mom's day!

Time: Approx. 6-8 minutes a flower

You will need:

Printout of page 4 if you have a color printer or page 5 for a black and white printer (each printout makes 2 flowers)

Wooden skewers

A glue stick



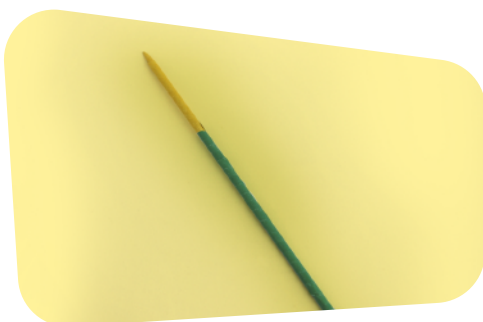
Step 1

Cut out the petal, the yellow and green strips. (If you have a black and white printer, color in the printout to match the color print before cutting out.) Using your glue stick, glue the entire back of the yellow strip of paper. Starting at the pointy end, with the slanting side of the strip, wrap the strip around the wooden skewer.



Step 2

Glue the entire back of the green strip and wrap around the skewer starting directly after the yellow strip. Start with the slanting side of the strip.



Step 3

Glue the second green strip and wrap around the skewer so that the skewer is completely covered. (If you have a short skewer, you may not need the second green strip.)



Step 4

Curl the petal into a roll, with the green on the outside. Hold gently in a roll shape for 10 seconds and then release.



Step 5

Using the glue stick, place glue on the bottom part of the petal as shown.



Step 6

Place the skewer down on the petal and press firmly at base of the petal to attach to glued section.



Step 7

Gently glue the right hand side of the petal.



Step 8

Insert your finger into the petal and gently stick the right hand side of the petal to the left. Do this carefully and try to keep the correct shape of the lilly.
